If you plan to have a **friend or relative**provide care and they **are not** a registered
or licensed provider **they also need to be approved.** They will complete the **PROVIDER** application. (**Legally Exempt**)

You will be notified by mail of the status of your application. If you are **DENIED**, you will be responsible for your child care expenses. If you are **APPROVED** based on your income, payment will come from Social Services and mailed directly to your provider.

The remaining child care expenses will be your responsibility.
