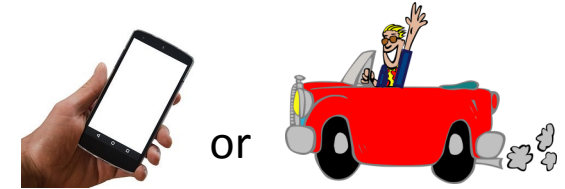


## What is Child Care Subsidy?

Child Care Subsidy is a Department of Social Services program that approves or denies applications and issues payment to the child care provider.

## How Do I Get Help Paying for Child Care?

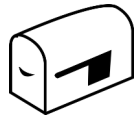


### Get an Application

Call Wyoming County Dept. of Social Services  
(585) 786-8900 and ask to speak to the  
CHILD CARE SUBSIDY UNIT

Mail or drive the completed **PARENT** application to the Department of Social Services Child Care Subsidy Unit for approval. Processing may take 30 days.  
**To mail: PO Box 231, Warsaw, NY 14569**

If you plan to have a **friend or relative** provide care and they **are not** a registered or licensed provider **they also need to be approved**. They will complete the **PROVIDER** application. (**Legally Exempt**)

If you don't know who will be your child care provider,

You will be notified by mail of the status of your application. If you are **DENIED**, you will be responsible for your child care expenses. If you are **APPROVED** based on your income, payment will come from Social Services and mailed directly to your provider.

The remaining child care expenses will be your responsibility.
