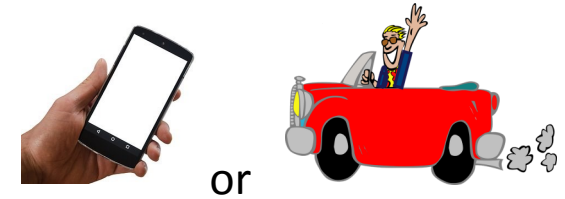


What is Child Care Subsidy?

Child Care Subsidy is a Department of Social Services program that approves or denies applications and issues payment to the child care provider.

How Do I Get Help Paying for Child Care?

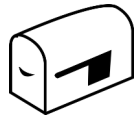


Get an Application

Call Allegany County Dept. of Social Services (585) 268-9622 and ask to speak to the CHILD CARE SUBSIDY UNIT

Or

Pick one up- (DSS) 7 Court Street, Belmont
or ACCORD ACCESS Center
or Child Care Services



or



Mail or drive the completed **PARENT** application to the Department of Social Services Child Care Subsidy Unit for approval. Processing may take 30 days.

If you plan to have a **friend or relative** provide care and they **are not** a registered or licensed provider **they also need to be approved**. They will complete the **PROVIDER** application. (**Legally Exempt**)

If you don't know who will be your child care provider,

You will be notified by mail of the status of your application. If you are **DENIED**, you will be responsible for your child care expenses. If you are **APPROVED** based on your income, payment will come from Social Services and mailed directly to your provider.

The remaining child care expenses will be your responsibility.
